# Criminal Justice

The criminal justice program provides a combined training and education package to prepare students for a professional career in the criminal justice system. This program is designed as a bachelor of science degree option for students who have completed or are completing an associate degree in Criminal Justice through Mott Community College. Any student who has earned an associate degree in Criminal Justice at either institution may transfer the identified credits toward the degree.

### General Admission Criteria

To be admitted to this program you must have an associate degree (or be working toward one) or have completed 48 transferable credit hours from an accredited college or university. An overall 2.0 cumulative grade point average is required, and you will need to submit official transcripts from all accredited colleges/universities with your application.
